Larger buildings should contact DCSEU for rebate information. Rebates for products installed after **3/31/19** are subject to change. Equipment model numbers for boilers, furnaces, and smart thermostats must be listed on the DCSEU's Qualifying Product Lists to be eligible for a rebate.
